NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

1. This is a skill-based contest and chance plays no part in the determination of winning.

3. Contest entries will be accepted from April 5, 2021 until April 30, 2021. One entry per person.
4. To submit your entry, follow the instructions and complete the entry form found at <https://trustonefinancial.org/Financial-Literacy-Contest> by 12pm noon CT on April 30, 2021. No other entry methods permitted. All entries become the property of TruStone Financial and may be used for any purpose. TruStone will not be required to pay any consideration, or seek any approval, for the use of the entries.
5. Entries will be judged by TruStone employees. There will be five winners, and they will be determined by the judges in their sole discretion. The decisions of the judges will be final and binding in all respects.
